Participants will be given the meeting link; the examiner will communicate with you directly.

1. Make sure proper internet connectivity before you join the link.
2. Keep the Computer or Laptop connected with headphones such a way that your upper body and hands are visible to the examiner. Candidate should look only on the screen rather than looking around.
3. **The examiner has full rights to disqualify the candidate for any malpractice noticed during the competition.**
4. Parents may install zoom meet and familiarize it with your ward from a different room.
5. Participants may record & save the ORAL round in the computer and need to share it with us as supporting proof for any disputes raised after the oral round

Interschool & State Level Ranking will be based on these score only, Oral rounds will be conducted using Google Meet, one to one, and time will be informed on the previous day by respective teacher.

STATE LEVEL GRAND FINALE will have oral rounds only (**SPELL IT RIGHT**)

SPELL IT RIGHT: - The examiner will play audio of the words and ask the contestant to spell aloud.

You can ask the examiner to play it again or repeat the word orally; ask for the meaning of the word if required. This round takes place on a miss-and -out basis, eliminating as they misspell a word from the 11th word onwards. The first 10 words are considered as WARM UP WORDS. This is an unlimited scoring round.

PREPARATORY MATERIALS: - Participants are requested to learn as many words as possible, their meanings with correct pronunciation. Refer any good dictionary (Cambridge/Oxford/Longman)

The wordlist provided is to enhance your vocabulary and understand the difficulty level.
